

MPM 1D Classroom Expectations

1) Washroom:

We will have a scheduled washroom time for the class. Additional washroom breaks are discouraged. If a student needs to use the washroom outside of that time frame, they must ask permission and sign out using the QR code in the classroom. The student needs to sign in on return. We have a designated set of washrooms in D hall that must be used.

2) Homework:

We will work through approximately three topics per day (online or in person) during our weeks of in class instruction, and one topic per day during our synchronous online learning sessions. Time will be provided in class to work, but additional practice will also need to be completed at home (approximately 30 – 45 minutes per night).

3) Disruptive Behaviour:

Disruptive behaviour constitutes any form of behaviour that interrupts the learning of the other students in the room. Students will be given a verbal warning initially. If the behaviour continues, the student will be dismissed to the hallway or the office.

4) Food and Drink:

Students will be granted specific times for nutrition breaks. Water can be on student desks at all times. Other snacks should be in student backpacks until it is time to eat.

5) Personal Electronic Devices:

Contrary to most years, students are asked to bring a personal device if possible (phone, tablet, laptop, etc.) to class. Course material will primarily be provided electronically, and all work submitted needs to be handed in electronically.

If a student is found using an electronic device in class for non-academic purposes, it will be confiscated, and they will have to pick it up at the end of the class. **Any student found using an electronic device during an assessment (aside from scanning their answers) will receive a mark of zero!**

6) Personal Belongings:

Students need to bring personal belongings to class since we do not have lockers available for use. Belongings must be placed beneath the student desk. Large items should be left at home. Students should have a water bottle, class materials, and snacks with them.

7) COVID 19 Guidelines

- Students must have masks on when in class. They may only be removed during a nutrition break or to take a sip of water.
- Desks are spaced two metres apart. The desks may not be moved, and students must adhere to the assigned seating plan at all times.
- There is to be no physical contact or sharing of items. Students needs to arrive with necessary materials. Any manipulatives used or materials borrowed will be sanitized between each use.
- All regulations as implemented by the GECSB are available at publicboard.ca under the Plan for Reopening.

8) Preparedness

Students are expected to come to class each day (online or in person) with all required materials ready to learn. A scientific calculator is essential for success in this course. Teachers are discouraged from the lending of materials, so please ensure that all school supplies come to school for in class days.
